- Why we collect personal information:
 - As a registered training organization (RTO), UIC collects your personal Information so we can process and manage your enrolment in a vocational education and training (VET) course with us:
- How we use your personal information:
 - We use your personal information to enable us to deliver VET courses to you, and otherwise, as needed, to comply with our obligations as an RTO
- How we disclose your personal information:

UIC is required by law (under the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011 (Cth) (NVETR Act)) to disclose the personal information we collect about you to the National VET Data Collection kept by the National Centre for Vocational Education Research Ltd (NCVER). The NCVER is responsible for collecting, managing, analyzing and communicating research and statistics about the Australian VET sector.
